



Adopt-A-Park Agreement Conditions

Adopters will adopt a site within the city limits to be determined by an agreement between the Adopters and the City of Victoria.

The Adopters will choose a member to serve as spokesperson/contact person for the group if there is more than one individual adopting the area.

Adopters must clean the site monthly on an agreed-upon date.

Post-cleanup report forms must be completed and submitted via email or hand delivery to 532 McCright Drive within 72 hours of cleaning the site.

The Adopters will agree to a minimum of a one-year agreement, which may be renewed.

Litter Pick-Up

The City of Victoria will be responsible for supplying trash bags for the group if needed. Requests for bags must be made seven days in advance of cleanup.

The City of Victoria will pick up and dispose of the trash bags filled by the Adopters after they complete each cleanup. The filled trash bags may be left in a neat pile at an agreed-upon location. The City of Victoria must be notified in advance of your scheduled cleanup day so that arrangements can be made to collect the filled trash bags.

The Adopters should not pick up any materials other than household garbage that can fit inside of a trash bag. Should any hazardous waste or large items such as old furniture, large appliances, etc. be found during litter pickup, the Adopters should note the location and notify the City of Victoria.

The City reserves the right to end adoptions and remove Adopt-a-Park signage in cases where litter is not reasonably picked up according to Adoption guidelines.

Safety

Each Adopter will be responsible for maintaining a first-aid kit while participating in cleanups.

Participants agree to obey all safety regulations that may be required by the City of Victoria.

When participants are 15 years of age or younger, the Adopters will furnish adult supervision. During that time, the adults will be held responsible for the participants' safety.

Signage

The City of Victoria agrees to provide an Adopt-A-Park sign and include the name(s) of the individual/group after successful completion of an established probationary period of 6 months.
