Overview

The Players Committee represents the players in the Victoria Parks and Recreation Sports Leagues. This committee will be responsible for bringing forth concerns and suggestions for improvements to the Parks and Recreation staff.

Terms and Elections

- 1.) Committee will consist of 5 players elected by their peers.
- 2.) Committee will consist of two year term positions.
- 3.) A year will consist of spring, summer, and fall league seasons (winter season when available).
- 4.) Voting will take place after rosters have locked during the fall season.
- 5.) Committee members will meet before the start of each season and as needed at the Parks and Recreation Department office or Adult Softball Complex.
- 6.) Committee members must play in at least 2 adult league seasons each year.
- 7.) Each team manager or acting team manager will get one vote.
- 8.) If the Player's Committee chooses to meet outside of the normal Parks and Recreation scheduled meetings, the Player's Committee will contact the Parks and Recreation office to notify them of their meeting. A Parks and Recreation representative will be present at each committee meeting.
- 9.) A committee member who leaves his or her position on the committee before the end of the term, or is otherwise unable to complete his or her term will have the vacated position filled by the player with the next highest vote during the next voting session.
- 10.) A committee member who is ejected from a sports league game may be subject to removal from their position on the Players Committee pending the outcome of any appeals of the ejection.
- 11.) If the ejection is upheld, the player will be removed from the committee and deemed ineligible to run for any other committee election.
- 12.) When a complaint is made, the player with the complaint will bring it to their team manager and the manager will then bring it to the attention of the Players Committee. At that point the committee will bring it to the Recreation Staff. Any complaint regarding an incident must be submitted via email within 1 week of the incident occurring.
- 13.) Members of the Player's Committee are representatives of the league so should act in a manner reflecting that position. Poor sportsmanship, foul language, etc. will not be tolerated.
